What is the 21st Century SCHOLARS Program?

A unique program in academic subjects such as science, technology, engineering mathematics (STEM), arts and cultural education designed to provide academic enrichment opportunities after-school hours for students through project based learning. The 21st Century SCHOLARS Program aims to advance student achievement by promoting knowledge, skills, and understanding through enriching, hands-on and creative opportunities that complement the school day curricula.

The goals of the program are to help students meet state and local standards in core academic subjects, such as reading, math, science and language arts literacy. It also offers educational services to the families of participating students. This program also helps the student navigate the transition from high school to the college experience through college credit courses, career counseling, career and youth development workshops and FAFSA application assistance. Participants will have interactions with professionals from various career fields through a variety of seminars and/or workshops.
